**Competitions for students in five different categories**

1. **Drawing/painting - for all students:** Participants are invited to submit the scanned copy of artwork made in A4 sheet on or before **02.10.2020**, through E-mail. Students are assessed in five different categories. The name, class/age and studying institution, and contact details should be mentioned separately to be qualified for the competition.
2. **Essay writing - for high school and college students:** Send your writing not exceeding 1000 words on or before **02.10.2020**, through E- mail. The name, class/age and studying institution, and contact details should be mentioned separately to be qualified for the competition.
3. **Collage making - for higher primary, high school and college students:** Submit the scanned copy of handwork made in A4 sheet on or before **02.10.2020**, through E-mail. Students are assessed in three different categories. The name, class/age and studying institution, and contact details should be mentioned separately to be qualified for the competition.

**Wildlife Photography competition for general public**

Open for all, participants have to send high resolution photos of Indian wildlife species taken in the wild or in any Biological Parks (Zoo) on or before **02.10.2020**, through E-mail.

Location, date of the photography and name of the photographer along with contact details should be mentioned separately to be qualified for the competition.
